Does the sound of any particular musical instrument move you deeply, and is there one that you simply cannot stand? Give examples and reasons, if you can.

At no point in the world's history have there been more books available than today; why do most of us read so little?

Has a book ever changed your life or made you see the world from a new point of view? What was it, when, and do you know why?

Have you ever written any poetry?

Is there a future for live theatre? Have you ever taken part in a play? Describe the experience in detail.
